Dow Named to Dow Jones Sustainability Index for Eighth Time

Dubai, United Arab Emirates (UAE) – 15 October 2008 – The Dow Jones Sustainability World Index recently announced it had rated The Dow Chemical Company as one of the top performers in the global chemical industry – marking the eighth time Dow has received this recognition since the launch of the Index in 1999.

The Company was recognized for its operational eco-efficiency, product stewardship, customer relationship management and people development, among other things. Dow's overall score was 85 percent – 24 percentage points higher than the average and just two points lower than the top score in the industry. Dow was one of nine chemical companies who made this year's list – which includes a total of 320 companies from 19 super sectors.

"Once again we are honored to be recognized by Dow Jones, reinforcing the positive impact we're making with our sustainability efforts across the Company," said Dave Kepler, executive vice president and chief sustainability officer. "As the global marketplace increases its demand for sustainable solutions, Dow is well positioned to lead the chemical industry in meeting and exceeding these demands."

"This external validation not only recognizes the work we're doing to set the standard for sustainability within the chemical industry but is also a testament to the personal commitment that the people of Dow Chemical across the India, Middle East & Africa (IMEA) region are making," said John Dearborn, president, Dow Chemical IMEA. "As leaders in the industry, we're using our expertise in science and technology to address critical challenges facing our world."
