GRC appointed as Voith's official Retarder Service Partner-Western Cape Region

Voith Turbo South Africa (Pty) Ltd, one of South Africa's most trusted suppliers of class leading Retarders for extra heavy trucks and buses, automatic transmissions for buses as well as related services, has appointed Cape Town based Gearbox Repair Centre (Pty) Ltd. Voith Retarders are fitted either as standard or optional to Mercedes-Benz, Volvo, Renault and Isuzu XHCV's. Wraight says that other heavy vehicle brands are expected to follow shortly. "The increase in demand from the Far East is so great that it has prompted the establishment of a Voith Retarder manufacturing facility in China. South African demand is also increasing rapidly and it is our commitment to meet this growth and to reduce transporters' downtime that persuaded Voith to expand its footprint and increase its presence in the Western Cape".
