One of the key components of the basic engineering phase is to perform detailed up-front planning and to develop a viable and cost-effective project execution strategy to safely drive the efficient delivery of the project within the approved budget, schedule and specification.

The basic engineering phase of the project will initially be led from Fluor's Woodmead office in South Africa with additional expertise from other Fluor global locations.
