Cooperation between transport logistic and CTL in India

After China and Turkey, transport logistic is now also expanding into India.

As part of a cooperation agreement Messe München International will for the first time be involved in CTL – Cargo Transport Logistics 2016, the 9th International Expo & Conference. "CTL in co-operation with transport logistic" takes place on February 18 and 19, 2016 in Mumbai.
