AfriSam also funded the construction of new ablution facilities for the school in 2012, comprising three toilets with a total of 14 seats. Past contributions from AfriSam include building a perimeter fence around the school as well as the provision of school shoes for the learners.

"We hope that these facility improvements will serve as motivation for more learners to enrol at the school and get educated, with the vision of a better future for themselves and their people," Tsuene says.
