

Enstrom offers Factory Standard Technical Training Course

Enstrom Helicopter Corporation has completed presenting a factory standard technical course in South Africa at Grand Central Airport, Midrand, Gauteng.

The course, which spanned for a period of a week, covered all the technical aspects of the Enstrom 280 Piston and 480 Turbine helicopter range and will enable the attendees to obtain Aircraft Maintenance Engineer (AME) ratings on the Enstrom product range.
