It is an intentional opportunity for departments to build relationships and establish best methods of practice in their own teams by sharing in the experiences and knowledge of other municipality teams over the three day event.

As Phindile Maseko, from JMPD, said, "It's not just about sports but it is about learning what we can do differently in our workplace from others." It is for this reason that Corobrik was happy to support and sponsor the event, generously donating not bricks and pavers but 20 cycle shirts and 20 Corobrik bags to the JPMD team.
